

What to do *- when there's a -* *power outage*

1. Check to see if there's a blown fuse or tripped circuit breaker at your service panel.
2. If the power is still off, check to see if the outage includes other houses in your neighborhood.
3. If the lights are off at your house and your neighbors', call AMP at 510.748.3902.
4. For updates on the outage, check out AMP on Facebook and Twitter.

Report downed wires immediately to AMP or the police department. Never go near a downed power line and never touch trees or any obstacles in contact with power lines.

Safety tips

- during an -

outage



Keep flashlights, a battery-powered radio and fresh batteries in an easily accessible place.



Turn off major appliances, such as room air conditioners, and unplug other electronics like TVs and computers. This will prevent damage to them if there's a power surge when the electricity returns.



Leave one light on so you can tell when power is turned back on.



Keep refrigerator and freezer doors closed. Most food in the fridge will last 24 hours except dairy products, which should be discarded after six hours.
