



A GUIDE TO *The* MODERN LIGHTBULB

Choose bulbs by how bright you need them to be. (The higher the lumens, the brighter the light.)

Warm vs Cool. The packaging should indicate the quality/feel of the light. (Warm is most like standard incandescent bulbs.)

LIGHTBULB DISPOSAL

CFL bulbs contain mercury, a toxic element, and must be managed as hazardous waste. LEDs are NOT hazardous waste, but are classified as electronic waste.
