



RIDER EAC ENERGY ADJUSTMENT CHARGE

PURPOSE

The Energy Adjustment Charge (EAC) is a charge per kWh which provides for the recovery of power supply and purchased power related costs incurred by Alameda Municipal Power to serve customers that are not adequately recovered in the base rates. These costs include market purchases, hydropower availability impacts, and other power supply related charges. The EAC shall be established twice per year with the intention of matching EAC revenues with actual power costs over the course of a fiscal year, giving consideration to seasonal fluctuations in load and in purchased power prices.

APPLICABILITY

This surcharge is applied to the bills for electric service for all Alameda Municipal Power customers.

RATE

An amount in cents per kWh, rounded to the nearest \$0.00001, calculated biannually in accordance with the formula below shall be added to or subtracted from all rate classes. All adjustments to the EAC shall be approved by the Public Utilities Board.

The EAC will be calculated as follows:

The sum of:

- a) The net short term energy market purchases and NCPA Pool purchases
- b) An amount determined by Alameda Municipal Power as the projected over or under collected balance at the end of the recovery period minus the over or under collected balance of purchased power costs at the beginning of the recovery period

Divided by:

- c) Projected kWh sales
