



RIDER PV STATE SOLAR PHOTOVOLTAIC PROGRAM CHARGE

PURPOSE

State Senate Bill (SB1) mandates all California utilities to offer rebates for the installation of solar photovoltaic (PV) systems on customers' premises. Under the law, Alameda Municipal Power (AMP) is required to offer \$4,200,000 in rebates over a 10-year period to customers installing solar PV systems. This charge collects funds to pay for the solar program rebates.

APPLICABILITY

This charge is applied to all kilowatt-hours (kWh) for all AMP customers except those s taking service under the Energy Assistance Program (Rider EA) the Medical Discount Program (Rider MD), Outdoor Street and Area Lighting (Schedule OL), Municipal Electric Service – Street Lighting (Schedule M-2), and Municipal Electric Service (Schedule M-1).

RATE

The rate paid effective with this rate schedule is \$0.00165 per kWh.

TERM

According to the language within SB1 referencing the solar rebate law, the solar rebate program will continue through December 31, 2017. After which, Rider PV will no longer be in effect.
